



## Fowey Town Centre

Following our work in March to address immediate safety hazards and prepare road surfaces for a durable finishing layer, we will be returning to complete the repairs on 19, 21 and 22 May.

For safety reasons, road closures will need to be in place while the work is underway. To minimise disruption, work will be carried out between 6pm and 11pm.

Access for residents will be maintained via marshalled gateways. However, please be aware that material curing times may cause delays. We recommend residents plan ahead and allow extra time for their journeys during this period.

## What work is taking place?

We will use Elastomac to complete the road surface repairs. Using this material will reduce the number of vehicle movements through the town centre, minimising disruption.

Elastomac is a hot, flexible, rubberised material that requires no cutting or compaction and is used to treat road surface defects, forming a waterproof bond that prevents water ingress.

We completed several areas in March, but due to poor weather, site access constraints, and limited working hours during the initial phase, some sections remain unfinished. For safety reasons we now need to finish this work.

## Access arrangements

Access will be maintained for residents through marshalled gateways. Please be aware that, due to the specialist materials and processes involved, delays are possible. We need to allow adequate time for the material to cure before it can be trafficked.

We will do our best to minimise disruption as much as possible. Please observe all site notices and any safety instructions given by our workforce.
