14/07 Development of OGS Garden

14/08 Review of Grass Cutting and Weed Killing

Schedule for 2014/15 will remain unchanged. Cllr. Alexander volunteered to contact LGS instructing them to continue.

14/09 Local Maintenance Partnership

With costs for grass cutting and weed killing increasing and grants from Cornwall Council reducing, it is necessary to be part of the LMP. Proposed Cllr Alexander, seconded Cllr Eardley and RESOLVED that Fowey Town Council should continue to be a member of the LMP for 2014/15.

14/10 Allotments

There is a new gate into the Allotments although the gap between the gate and hedge has not yet been closed off. A Working Party has dug a trench to take the water pipe to the centre of the new allotments and a new stand-pipe has to be sourced.

Parking passes issued by Estuary Cottages have been allocated which should ease some of the congestion that occasionally occurs in the original allotments.

14/11 To Receive Reports from Members

Cllr Finlay has applied for some of Cllr Hughes' Community Chest Money to buy Cornish Apple trees to plant around the new allotments. Duchy Nurseries has quoted £15 per sapling and it is expected the Environment Committee will purchase for Autumn planting.
